


The Fine Line 1200 is a 4-track Stereophonic and Monophonic recorder/player. It records 4-track stereo and mono, plays 4-track stereo and 4-track, half, or full track mono tapes. Among non-professional recorders, the 1200 is the ultimate in electrical and mechanical performance. For the hi-fi enthusiast and serious recordist, it is both a source of professional quality sound and a means of recording professional quality sound. At the same speed (for example 7½ ips), the Fine Line 1200 has the SAME frequency response and low noise rating as Ampex professional broadcast recorders.

FEATURES

- THREE SEPARATE, PROFESSIONALIZED HEADS-erase, record, playback-no dual purpose heads, no compromise-each head designed for maximum performance
- FINE LINE ALIGNMENT—special design of frame and parts that move and guide the tapeholds tape in an ultra-precise position on the heads-necessary for 4-track recording and playing
- CROSS-TALK ELIMINATED—results from Fine Line Alignment plus innovations in head shielding between channels-no signal "leak" from adjacent tracks

INSIDE THE FINE LINE 1200



The success of any tape mechanism, especially 4track, is dependent upon the rigidity and precision of its basic frame. A light weight or stamped metal frame may warp and cause critical parts to move out of alignment, with resulting loss of response and cross-talk.

Ampex uses an EXTRA HEAVY die cast frame in the Fine Line 1200. The top surface of this frame is micro-milled so all parts are permanently held in a "fine line" with each other; this frame will not warp. For exceptional long life with low flutter and wow, critical moving parts in the Fine Line 1200 rotate in EXTRA LONG bearings mounted in the die cast frame.



PROFESSIONAL ELECTRONICS...


An important factor in any tape machine is the quality of its record and playback electronics. Conventional mass production or dual purpose electronics result in insensitive, noisy performance and poor frequency response. For truly professional performance, the Fine Line 1200 has separate record and playback electronics sections, each dual channel, similar in design and construction to those in Ampex broadcast recorders.




PROFESSIONAL TYPE HEADS ...


All three heads in the Fine Line recorder/player are precision mounted in mu metal shielding cases for effective inter-channel isolation. Outer and inner shielding results in pick-up and recording of signals in a straight line from the heads, instead of the "funnel-like" operation of other makes. No signal from an adjacent track can "leak" into either quarter track pick-up area in the playback head. Improved overall response of the Fine Line heads results in quarter track performance that equals or exceeds former 2-track stereo or half-track mono.








MODEL 1260 – a portable 4-track stereo and mono recorder/player in attractive grey luggage – with record electronics and playback preamplifiers – can be used in a fixed music system, or easily transported for on-the-spot recording or playback over one or two 2012 portable amplifier/speakers – ideal for semi-professional recording and long-life service in education, business, theater, church or audio-visual systems.







MODEL 1270 – a portable 4-track stereo and mono recorder/player with pair of self-contained amplifiers and speakers (one in each end of case) – can be used as a recorder or music source with external amplifiers and speakers, or as a self-contained unit – built-in amplifier/speakers allow on-the-spot playback of tapes at volumes suitable for most normal sized rooms or classrooms – ideal unit for all-around user in home, education, business or church.
