

All you do is place a reel of tape on the recorder, pull the tape through the head assembly and drop it in the "magic slot."

EXCLUSIVE DUAL CAPSTAN DRIVE

Provides perfect tape-to-head contact without utilizing wear-

producing pressure pads, as well as providing the ideal method of controling tape tension. Because of Dual Capstan Drive, wow and flutter are practically eliminated . . . even at the slow speeds.

VERSATILE 3-SPEED OPERATION

Select $7\frac{1}{2}$ i.p.s.(inches per second) for truest fidelity; $3\frac{3}{4}$ i.p.s. for extra long-play mood music; or $1\frac{1}{8}$ i.p.s. for voice recording.

SOLID STATE ELECTRONICS

All electronics in the 2100 Series are solid state, assuring long, reliable use. Ready to play or record instantly without warm up. In the pre-amplifier where requirements are extremely critical, silicon transistors are used. To reduce heat, all components of power amplifier are mounted on anodized aluminum heat sink. Tantalum capacitators are used to increase reliability. By using these components, plus printed circuits, weight is reduced, service problems minimized and years of trouble-free operation assured.

ADDITIONAL OUTSTANDING FEATURES

Finger-tip reverse, bass boost tone control, automatic tape lifters, monitor switch, automatic cue provision, and push button digital counter.

Exclusive All-Inclusive One Year Warranty

All 2100 Series tape recorders carry an unconditional one year warranty. Should your recorder fail within this period (due to manufacturing or material defects) Ampex will repair your recorder at absolutely no charge to you.

AVERAGE PERFORMANCE SPECIFICATIONS
